RULES AND REGULATIONS

Finalists MUST be available to compete at the Finals Gala evening on July 21st (age 15 and under) or July 22nd (age 16 and over) 2012.

Bursary Winners are required to perform at the Award Presentation Gala Oct. 13th at the Markham Theatre.

DVD's and photos will not be returned.

Ideally, taping should take place from one camera, and encompass the full performance area at a reasonable distance. Please ensure that your individual performance is clearly visible. Group performances will not be helpful if the applicant is a soloist. Performance videos shot from too great a distance are not helpful. All submissions will be judged by three experienced judges.

Videos should have been produced within the past 6 months.

- 1. This competition is only open to amateur performers of all ages, not professionals (members of a union or professional association related to the applicant's discipline) who are currently enrolled in an educational process.
- 2. No Refunds will be issued for any entry.
- 3. Entries MUST be received by 4:00pm June 2, 2012 at the Newmarket Theatre or above newspaper locations.
- 4. All applicants will be informed, by email, regarding their status and their assigned performance date.
- 5. Any proposed changes to original submitted entries of accepted contestants must be in writing no verbal requests will be honored. Proposed changes to original entries MUST be submitted and received 14 days prior to the assigned performance date or they WILL NOT be considered. Proposed changes may or may not be allowed.
- 6. Accepted contestants are required to perform the selected piece in the preliminaries in the same manner as they did in their audition tape.
- 7. Contestants advancing to the **finals** may choose to perform a different piece than was performed in the semi-finals.
- 8. Contestants must perform in the same category in the Finals for which they qualified in the preliminaries.
- 9. Contestants' age category is based on their age as of July 15th 2012. Age categories are 12 and under, 13-15, 16-18, 19 and up in each discipline.
- 10. Individuals may only enter this competition once, unless in two distinctly different categories i.e. Vocal and Dance. Entries in vocal with a Broadway song and a classical song is not considered two categories. The category is vocal.
- 11. Soloists may also enter as part of a group entry, provided the group contains at least 2 members.
- 12. A past bursary winner may only compete again if they are in a new age category, a new discipline, or group vs. solo from their successful previous win.
- 13. Video Taping, audio recording and movie cameras are strictly prohibited in the theatre during performances. No flash photography.

- 14. Acts may last no longer than 4 minutes (5 minutes for classical pieces) from the time the entertainment begins. Any act longer than the maximum time limit will be penalized (1 mark for each 10 seconds) or disqualified. Set-up time is limited to 2 minutes.
- 15. Each act will be judged in the following way: Technical Mastery, Performance Ability, Overall Impression.

 Total possible points: 100

Scores will not be made public. Score sheets will not be available for review.

The judges will not be commenting publicly on performances.

THE JUDGES' DECISIONS ARE FINAL.

- 16. The Town of Newmarket, The Newmarket Theatre, STAR Productions (formerly Marquee Productions), and the York Region Media Group will not be held responsible or liable in any way for any accidents or injuries or damage to person or property that might occur as a result of participation in this contest.
- 17. Performers and their parties will be held personally responsible for any and all damages to the theatre, theatre equipment or other property not belonging to them.
- 18. Stage monitors, microphones and sound mixing equipment will be provided for the competition, however, it will be the responsibility of the participants to provide their own musical instruments, amplifiers, props and costumes.
- 19. A grand piano is available for use in classical or acoustic entries.
- 20. All vocal, dance and instrumental (excluding piano) submissions must perform with an accompanist. In the event that a participant does not have a live accompanist, performance backing music or accompaniment must be provided on CD or an emailed MP3 (preferred) and must have lyrics and backing vocals removed. Lip-synching is not permitted. CDs must be clearly labeled with the performer's name, and the title of the piece. If using a CD, the Contestant will bring 2 separate copies of their CD in the unlikely event that one doesn't read in the machine.
- 21. Lyrics are permissible on backing music for dance routines.
- 22. All performances are monitored for content of inappropriate lyrics and gestures. Anyone who is in violation of this performance requirement will be removed from the competition immediately.
- 23. Freestanding props are allowed however, fire, pyrotechnics, swords or knives are NOT permitted.
- 24. The York Region Celebration of the Arts and York Region Talent Search, does not discriminate. We are an equal opportunity competition for the purpose of performing arts evaluation.
- 25. There is a \$30.00 non-refundable administration fee for each act. All cheques should be made payable to the **"Town of Newmarket"** and must be returned with the entry form. Forms returned without the entry fee will not be considered. Credit card payments may be made by filling out the enclosed form.
- 26. A \$35.00 charge and disqualification from the competition will result in any NSF cheques.
- 27. Accepted applicants agree to attend a dress rehearsal to be held during the daytime, on the same day as their booked evening semi-final performance.
- 28. All showcases (preliminaries and two final Gala events) will be presented at the Newmarket Theatre, 505 Pickering Crescent in Newmarket. Accepted entrants agree to perform live at one of the preliminary/semi-final evening productions. The management team reserves the right to dictate on which evening the accepted acts will perform.
- 29. All contestants/winners agree to attend press conferences and phone interviews during and/or following the events and agree to release their photos for publicity of the contest. Contestants also agree to allow their acts to be video taped for public broadcast.
- 30. **An applicant's signature on the attached application form signifies** their acceptance of and agreement to abide by all of the rules and regulations stated above.
